Safiya Homes Lahore (SHL) is an eco-friendly and government-approved affordable housing project on the outskirts of the historic city of Lahore, Pakistan. For the first time in Pakistan, low-income households have access to safe, green, and resilient housing to claim as their own. Spread over a 37-acre parcel with tree-lined roads and lush green parks, SHL features 24/7 security with infrastructure services such as fully paved roads, a centralized water supply system, an underground sewerage system, full-time electricity, a center of worship, community and commercial centers, a graveyard, and a water filtration plant.

SHL Homes is the first EDGE-certified housing project in Pakistan. Safiya Homes has received final EDGE certification from GBCI.
